

ORIGINAL ORDINANCE NO. 1880

ENROLLED ORDINANCE NO. 1648

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 13.62.090 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE TO PERMIT THE CITY MANAGER TO WAIVE LANDFILL FEES FOR GROUPS PERFORMING COMMUNITY CLEANUP AND ESTABLISHING THE PROCEDURE.

WHEREAS, there are a number of local groups who perform services for the benefit of the public by gathering the accumulated trash and garbage around the community and depositing such in the City landfill; and,

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the benefit of such activities to the community in the visual improvement to the areas cleaned by such groups; and,

WHEREAS, the Albany County Commissioners have cooperated with the City in providing two days per year where the regular tipping fees at the City landfill are waived by the City, and the County has reimbursed the City for the extraordinary costs associated with disposing of particular items brought to the landfill by Albany County residents; and,

WHEREAS, the City wishes to promote and support clean-up activities within the City by providing a waiver of certain fees for the groups providing the community benefit, and certain fees for those County residents wishing to take advantage of the County cleanup days to the limits established by the County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LARAMIE that Section 13.62.090 be amended to read as follows:

Section 13.62.090 Landfill fee waiver for identified community and county cleanup events.

- A. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to waive such landfill fees for those events which are previously identified and approved by the office of the City Manager, and contribute to the overall cleanliness and appearance of the community, including the following instances:
1. Two days per year wherein the County Commissioners have agreed to reimburse the City for the items deposited by County residents for which the City incurs a cost to receive, ie; refrigerators, tires, electronic equipment, and similar items.
 2. Any community clean-up activity wherein a group wishes to collect trash, litter, and other debris, at a specified time and date with prior authorization for waiver

of fees upon delivery of the collected refuse to the City sanitary landfill, except for special handling items.


- B. No waiver of fees shall occur to the County residents for the items for which the City incurs a cost of disposal beyond the limit of reimbursement from the County.
- C. Local groups may apply for approval of community service events by contacting the office of the City Manager and completing the appropriate form. All fees for trash collected within the City limits on public property shall be waived for the approved events.
