

RESOLUTION 2013 - 98

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF SUBMITTING AN APPLICATION TO THE WYOMING DEPARTMENT OF STATE PARKS AND CULTURAL RESOURCES FOR A 2014 LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND GRANT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$50,000 FOR THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW PARK ADJACENT TO THE IMPERIAL HEIGHTS SUBDIVISION.

WHEREAS the Wyoming Department of State Parks and Cultural Resources has invited cities, towns, counties, and school and recreation districts to submit applications for 2014 Land and Water Conservation Fund grants to support projects that promote, develop, and support public outdoor recreation;

WHEREAS the City of Laramie intends to submit an application for a Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant to support the design and construction of a new park located in east Laramie adjacent to the Imperial Heights Subdivision;

WHEREAS the surrounding neighborhoods and the Parks, Tree, and Recreation Board support this project by passing a motion to approve the Resolution and forward onto Council for their consideration;

WHEREAS the Parks and Recreation Department solicited public input on December 5, 2013 in the form of a public meeting from the neighborhoods of Imperial Heights, Sherman Hills, Grandview Heights, Laramie Plains, Valley View and the community at large;

WHEREAS the Laramie City Council also gave full consideration to all public comments in advance of passing this Resolution at a Public Hearing;

WHEREAS as required by the grant, the new park is dedicated for use by the public in perpetuity.

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF LARAMIE WYOMING, RESOLVES:

Section 1. That foregoing all recitals are incorporated in and made part of this resolution by this reference.

Section 2. That the City Council supports the filing of an application to the Wyoming State Parks and Cultural Resources for a 2014 Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant in an amount not to exceed \$50,000 for the design and construction of a new park adjacent to the Imperial Heights Subdivision.




