

**RESOLUTION 2014- 87**

**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF SUBMITTING AN APPLICATION TO THE WYOMING DEPARTMENT OF STATE PARKS AND CULTURAL RESOURCES FOR A 2015 LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND GRANT IN AN AMOUNT OF \$115,000 FOR PHASE 2 OF THE IMPERIAL HEIGHTS PARK DEVELOPMENT PROJECT.**

**WHEREAS** the Wyoming Department of State Parks and Cultural Resources has invited cities, towns, counties, and school and recreation districts to submit applications for 2015 Land and Water Conservation Fund grants to support projects that promote, develop, and support public outdoor recreation;

**WHEREAS** the City of Laramie intends to submit an application for a 2015 Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant to support construction of Phase 2 of the Imperial Heights Development Project;

**WHEREAS** based on the 2013 public meeting and public hearing comments, the staff recommended to the Parks, Tree and Recreation Advisory Board to create an Imperial Heights Park Ad Hoc Citizen Advisory Committee, which was formed in January of 2014 with four members from the neighborhood and three members from the Parks, Tree and Recreation Advisory Board;

**WHEREAS** the Parks and Recreation Department solicited public comments on December 4, 2014 in the form of a public meeting from the Imperial Heights neighborhood and community at large;

**WHEREAS** the Laramie City Council also gave full consideration to all public comments in advance of passing this Resolution with a public hearing held on December 9, 2014;

**WHEREAS** as required by the grant, Imperial Heights Park is dedicated for use by the public in perpetuity.


**NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF LARAMIE WYOMING, RESOLVES:**

**Section 1.** That foregoing all recitals are incorporated in and made part of this resolution by this reference.

**Section 2.** That the Laramie City Council supports the filing of an application to the Wyoming State Parks and Cultural Resources for a 2015 Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant in an amount of \$115,000 for Phase 2 of the Imperial Heights Park Development Project.



# IMPERIAL HEIGHTS PARK SITE






## CONCEPTUAL PARK PLAN


